Spectators at Camden Hills Events

Spectators will be permitted to attend Camden Hills sporting events whenever possible.

Some opponent venues, opposing schools, or conference-based events may not permit visiting school fans, or any fans at all for that matter, at THEIR home contests. This is a local control issue that we must abide by. If Camden Hills spectators will not be permitted to attend events, that will be communicated ahead of time through the schools.

Spectators will be required to wear masks at all times during all indoor activities – this includes venues outside of the high school campus, such as pools and rinks.

Camden Hills is not currently limiting spectator capacity at events in the Camden Hills gymnasium; however, we reserve the right to modify this approach should the need arise.

At events at MRC for Ice Hockey, our student/athletes will be given a certain number of tickets to distribute as they see fit. Only people on the list may attend games, with everyone sitting on the bleachers (with the exception of a few people allowed in the balcony).

At events at the YMCA for Swimming, we can allow 2 spectators for each home team swimmer. No visiting spectators at this time.

Home and away spectators must sit in the designated bleacher/seating areas as identified in all the various venues. Efforts to separate and distance from other household groups within the bleachers, to the extent possible, are appreciated.
