Celebrating Agriscience and Construction Trades

Mooresville's newest academic building was on display Tuesday as students from Construction Trades and Agriscience led tours through their new learning areas.

With the total renovation, the trades building now includes four classrooms, an updated greenhouse, and large open spaces for project-based learning. At the ceremony, Superintendent Dr. Jake Allen shared that the facility is already in use by 380 students in grades 8-12, which represents 20 percent of the MHS and PHMS population.

Agriscience and Construction Trades pathways include a dozens different classes, eight of which are dual credit or advanced placement courses.

Visitors were invited to pound nails into a sign being made for the building as well as pick up plants grown by students and seed packets. Students also shared information about projects they were working on for their classes as well as skills they will use to compete in FFA and Skills USA competitions.

Moore'sville Food Services staff members aren't just preparing food these days, they're growing it, too! The MHS/PHMS cafeteria is home to the new Pioneer Cafe Hydroponic Farm.

The plants are grown in nutrient-rich water on grow towers in the cafeteria for all students to see. Items currently being grown include butterhead lettuce, dill, cilantro, basil, green star lettuce, romaine lettuce, parsley, summer crisp lettuce. MHS students who complete work skills activities with the cafeteria staff will also be helping harvest the items.

School Bus Safety Reminders: ALL stops within the Mooresville Schools' district area are on two-lane or multi-lane paved across roadways, meaning all traffic in BOTH directions must stop when the bus stops. MHS HOME FOOTBALL GAME GUIDELINES

Any student not in high school must be accompanied by an adult parent or guardian for the entire game.

All attendees must remain in the stands, concession area, or restrooms.

Concourse areas must remain clear for safety.
